Saturday February 10 at 10:00 AM (Top 4 spots are guaranteed into the Semi-Finals)
(Must have 16 or more entries, if less than 16, 1 out of 4 spots are guaranteed)

Saturday February 10 at 1:00 PM (Top 4 spots are guaranteed into the Semi-Finals)
(Must have 16 or more entries, if less than 16, 1 out of 4 spots are guaranteed)

Semi-Finals (Top 16) **Lanes will be reconditioned**

Saturday February 10 at 4:00 PM

Top 16 qualifiers after 4 games will bowl 4 additional games with carry over from the 4 qualifying games.

Finals (Top 8)

Sunday February 11 at 1:00 PM

The 8 bowlers with the highest 8 game total will advance to bowl an 8 game Peterson Points match.

Totals from the first 8 games will not carry over.

Each finalist will receive bonus Peterson Points based on their qualifying seed. (See Rule #9 for clarification)

The bowler with the most points at the end of the 8 game match is the champion.

GRUSBC Assn Masters Tournament Rules

1. Only 2017-18 Genesee Region USBC Association members carrying an average of at least 21 games are eligible. All bowlers must be USBC certified for the current 2017-2018 season. Entrants may require proof of their USBC individual membership card.
2. One Re-Entry is allowed, but an individual can cash only once. **A re-entry may be refused if it denies the opportunity of a first time entrant from competing on a qualifying squad. The priority of the re-entry waiting list is first come, first serve.**
3. Entries close on Saturday February 10 at 1:00 PM.
4. Maximum of 48 bowlers on all squads.
5. A tie for 16th place during the qualifying round will be settled by a one game roll-off on February 10.
6. The 17th place qualifier will be designated as the alternate and replace any bowler, who for whatever reason, cannot bowl in or during the four game block on Saturday February 10. The alternate will split any prize money won with the bowler he replaces up to a maximum of \$200. If the alternate wins more than \$200, the replaced bowler will only receive the maximum \$100 split with the alternate receiving the remainder.
7. A tie for 8th place after the 8 game block prior to the Finals will be settled by a one game roll-off on February 10.
8. The 9th place bowler will be designated as the alternate and replace any bowler, who for whatever reason, cannot bowl in or during the Finals. The alternate will split any prize money won with the bowler he replaces up to a maximum of \$200. If the alternate wins more than \$200, the replaced bowler will only receive the maximum \$100 split with the alternate receiving the remainder.
9. **The high eight game qualifier will receive 80 bonus Peterson Points; 2nd high qualifier 56 points; third, 48 points; fourth, 40 points; fifth, 32 points; sixth, 24 points; seventh, 16 points, and eighth, 8 points.**
10. All prizes will be paid in cash and prizes will be 100% returned and 1 out of 5 entries will cash.
11. All other USBC rules are in effect.
12. All decisions made by the Tournament Director are final.
